Starjack supports the mountain railways in Austria and Germany with a web-based ticket solution and their webshops. This also includes the production of individual keycards. The keycards can be purchased directly via starjack.at and the online shop of the mountain railway in question. The chip cards for the mountain railways allow customers unimpeded access through the turnstiles of the access system used, and allow entry without long queues at the ticket office. Until now, starjack had the customisation of the chip cards carried out by an external service provider. However, in order to improve the service and to adapt

Furthermore, the fact that it is also very intuitive and thus easy to use makes it the current little favourite at starjack. The DC-7600 enables individual designs for the various different mountain railways. At starjack, we are pleased about this investment in the new card printer.

Excellent print quality and watermarks

Retransfer printing technology is the next developmental stage in card printing. The image is first printed on a film and then transferred from the film to the card. This technique is suitable for full-surface, over-the-edge printing and improves reliability. Due to the high resolution of the printers, micro fonts, complex barcodes and detailed images can be reproduced in high quality. By using YMCKH colour ribbons, customised watermarks and logos can be achieved quickly and at reasonable value as extra safety features.

High productivity and easy handling

With an output of 144 cards per hour for single-sided colour printing, the DASCOM printer is ideal for medium to large-scale batches. Inserting the consumable materials is child's play. Both the YMCK ribbons and the transfer ribbon are optimally matched to each other and thus enable the unsupervised printing of up to 250 cards at a time.

Easy connection

The printer has a USB interface as standard. The standard scope of delivery also includes an Ethernet interface, which enables use within a network.

A wide range of cards

The DC-7600 can process cards made of different materials – ranging from PVC and PET via polycarbonate to ABS. With dimensions of 85.6 x 53.98, standard ISO ID-1/CR-80 formats can accordingly be processed, while the bending device installed as standard also ensures perfectly flat cards – even with double-sided printing.
